RUNNING ORDER: Certification Runs, Trial

TRIAL HOURS: Entries open at 7:30 and close at 8:00. Trial starts at 8:30 AM

ROLL CALL: 8:00 AM, followed by the draw; any hound not present will be scratched.

CERTIFICATION RUNS:

- Dogs wishing to attempt a certification run must be at least 12 months old on the day of the trial
- All dogs attempting to certify must run in a muzzle
- To pass the certification run, the dog must complete the course with enthusiasm, running with at least one other dog, and show no inclination to interfere with the other dog(s) at any time during the course

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE REGULAR STAKES:

- Must be certified to run in the Regular Stakes (see above)*
- Must be at least 12 months old on the day of the trial

STAKES OFFERED:

Open Stake – Open to all dogs aged 1 year or older on the day of the trial. To be eligible for entry in the open stake, each dog must have previously qualified by completing one qualifying run with

another dog of the same breed or running style.

Singles Stake – Open to all dogs aged 1 year or older on the day of the trial, including those which have previously disqualified to run in the open stake. Not eligible for BOB or BIT competition, but will receive placements within the singles stake. **SINGLES ENTRY LIMITED TO 8 DOGS TOTAL EACH DAY**

SCORING/RUNNING FORMATS:

Category Scored Braces (Open Stakes) – Dogs will run in groups of two, separated into breed or mixed divisions. Each dog will run a prelim course and a final course, and will receive a numerical score (out of 100) based on the following categories: speed, agility, stamina, honest pursuit, and desire. Dogs will be ranked within their division based on the combined prelim/final scores. Dogs with the highest combined prelim/final scores in their breed/mixed division will be eligible to compete for Best in Trial (BIT)

Category Scored Singles (Singles Stake) – Dogs will run alone, and will NOT be separated into breed or mixed divisions. Each dog will run a prelim course and a final course, and will receive a numerical score (out of 100) based on the following categories: speed, agility, stamina, honest pursuit, and desire. Dogs will be ranked based on the combined prelim/final scores.

EQUIPMENT:

A battery powered, drag loop system with back-up equipment will be used. The Field Committee reserves the right to switch to a continuous loop system if weather or field conditions so require it. The lure will be white or colored plastic streamers and/or fur. The course plan will be reversed as each bracket advances.

AWARDS:

Ribbons will be awarded for all placements (1st through 5th) in the open and singles stakes, as well as Best in Trial.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Muzzles – All dogs are required to wear muzzles, whether they are running in the regular stakes or certification runs. The muzzle must provide adequate room for the dog to open their mouth and breathe without allowing the dog to bite another dog or the lure.

Responsibility –All owners must keep their dogs under control at all times, and must clean up after them. There will be a \$15.00 fine assessed against anyone who fails to maintain control of or clean up after their dog.

PLEASE NOTE; There are horses and riders present on the park grounds. If you dog is not safe around horses and/or livestock, please do not attend this trial!

There will be a \$10 fine assessed against the owner of any loose dog on the field not taking part in a course in progress.

There will be a \$15 fine assessed against owner who does not clean up after his dog.

Entries will not be acknowledged by mail or phone. Substitutes for lame or in-season hounds will be allowed if substitute has the same owner and field secretary is notified before close of entries.

FUN RUNS AND PRACTICE RUNS:

We will be offering fun runs and practice runs throughout the day as time allows. If you are attending specifically to do fun/practice runs, the best time to arrive would be around noon. Fun Runs and Practice Runs will start at \$5.00 per dog per run and go up depending on distance.
