RUNNING ORDER: Coursing Tests, Regular Stakes

TRIAL HOURS: Entries open at 7:30 and close at 8:00. Trial starts at 8:30 AM

ROLL CALL: 8:00 AM, followed by the draw; any hound not present will be scratched.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL ENTRIES:

- Must be at least twelve (12) months of age on the day of the event.
- On the day of the event, the dog must be permanently registered with UKC, have a valid UKC Temporary Listing (TL) number, or a UKC Limited Privilege (LP)/Performance Listing (PL) number
- Must be an eligible breed (See list on following page)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE REGULAR STAKES:

To be eligible for the Regular Stakes must EITHER:

- Have earned a Coursing Tested (CT) title, with at least one of the legs earned by running with competition; OR
- Have earned a racing or coursing title from another approved organization (See list on following page) *

***Proof of this title in the form of a photocopy of the title certificate must be included with the first entry at a UKC Coursing Meet.**

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE COURSING TEST (CT):

- See Eligibility Requirements for All Entries (Above)

ELIGIBLE BREEDS:

Only dogs of the following breeds are eligible for both the CT and Regular Stakes: Afghan Hound, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Canaan Dog, Carolina Dog, Chart Polski, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhound, Hungarian Greyhound, Ibizan Hound, Irish Wolfhound, Italian Greyhound, Lurcher, Longdog, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Pharaoh Hound, Podenco Canario, Podengo Portugueso (All size varieties), Rhodesian Ridgeback, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Silken Windhound, Sloughi, Spanish Greyhound, Thai Ridgeback, Whippet, Xoloitzcuintli, Limited Privilege/ Performance Listed dogs (designated as one of the above eligible breeds)

APPROVED TITLES FOR ENTRY IN THE REGULAR STAKES:

The following titles will exempt a dog from the CT requirement to enter the regular stakes. Proof of this title in the form of a photocopy of the title certificate must be included with the first entry at a UKC Lure Coursing Trial.

- Canadian Kennel Club: FCh, NC (Novice Courser)
- American Kennel Club: FC, SC
- American Sighthound Field Association: FCh, LCM
- Large Gazehound Racing Association: GRC
- National Oval Track Racing Association: ORC, OTR, SOR
- Canadian Amateur Racing Association: ORM, SRM, RChS, RChO
- Whippet Racing Association: CR, WRCH
- North American Whippet Racing Association: RCH, SR
- National Open Field Coursing Association: CC, CM
- International Silken Windhound Society: ISWS FCh

IMPORTANT: To earn a CT title, a dog must complete three qualifying runs, at least one of those runs being in competition with another dog. Each CT test allows for two (2) opportunities to qualify. Therefore, a dog who runs twice on Saturday and once on Sunday morning can potentially qualify to compete in the Regular Stakes on Sunday.

EQUIPMENT:

A battery powered, drag loop system with back-up equipment will be used. The Field Committee reserves the right to switch to a continuous loop system if weather or field conditions so require it. The lure will be white or colored plastic streamers and/or fur. The course plan will be reversed as each bracket advances.

AWARDS:

Stake winners will receive a blue ribbon; Runners-Up a red ribbon; Breed Leaders a purple ribbon; Qualifying CT runs earn a light blue ribbon.

A Best in Field trophy will be offered; this will be an unofficial competition open to Stake Winners and Breed Leaders.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Responsibility –All owners must keep their dogs under control at all times, and must clean up after them.

PLEASE NOTE; There are horses and riders present on the park grounds. If you dog is not safe around horses and/or livestock, please do not attend this trial!

There will be a \$10 fine assessed against the owner of any loose dog on the field not taking part in a course in progress.

There will be a \$15 fine assessed against owner who does not clean up after his dog.

Entries will not be acknowledged by mail or phone. Substitutes for lame or in-season hounds will be allowed if substitute has the same owner and field secretary is notified before close of entries.

FUN RUNS AND PRACTICE RUNS:

We will be offering fun runs and practice runs throughout the day as time allows. If you are attending specifically to do fun/practice runs, the best time to arrive would be around noon. Fun Runs and Practice Runs will start at \$5.00 per dog per run and go up depending on distance.
