DAY-OF-RACE INFORMATION

ENTERING THE FACILITY:

Entry into the park before 9:00am requires a gate code. Upon receiving you entries, the Race Secretary will send out the gate code via email/text. If you do not pre-enter, but plan to attend, please contact the Race Secretary by phone/text/email to obtain the gate code. There will be an \$8.00 gate fee per vehicle, to be paid at the Race Secretary's table upon checkin. Entrance onto the main park road will be directly to your left. Please note, there is a **SPEED LIMIT OF 5 MPH**. Please be respectful of the park's other patrons and do not exceed the speed limit. Furthermore, **THIS IS A ONE-WAY ROAD**, do not attempt to turn around and go back at any time; if you keep following the road you eventually end up back at the main gate where you can exit. Failure to respect these rules not only threatens our club's ability to use this venue, it will also result in refusal of entries by us.

PARKING INSTRUCTIONS:

We will be using the "Sports Courts" section of the park (see attached map). Please park in soccer field that is directly adjacent to the driving range. Please **DO NOT** park anywhere else, unless you have specifically reserved a camping space for yourself. Campsite reservations must be made with the park directly before the event (See page 3 for camping information).

Be prepared to set up secure and shaded quarters for your dog(s). You must work on the track when your dogs are not racing. Keep in mind that it takes seven (7) people other than those slipping and catching to run your dog!

ENTERING THE MEET

Pre-entry closes midnight the Wednesday before the meet. Please help us streamline race mornings by pre-entering your dogs. Fees are not due until race morning.

*** Pre-entries will be accepted by mail or email. When emailing your entries put "Pre-entry" in the subject line and the following information in the body of the email:

Dog's registered name
Dog's call name
Owner name
Breed
Sex

Height (mixed breeds only)

*** If entering by email please bring hard copies of the entry forms and/or registration forms with you on race morning.

FEES:

- Pre-entry: \$12.00 for first entry, \$10.00 for each additional entry, \$8.00 for veterans
- Day-of-race entry: \$15.00 with no available discount.
- Practice runs: \$3.00 per runQualifying runs: \$5.00 per run

** Checks should be made out to Olivia Hsia **

Day-of entries and registration begin at 7:30 am. Check in starts at 8:00 a.m. Drawing of heats at 8:30 a.m. Racing begins at 9 a.m.

All dogs entered in the race meet must be present for check-in/roll call at **8:00am** or else they will forfeit their entry and fees.

All day-of entries must be received by the race secretary at the registration table by **8:00am**, after which the first program of races will be drawn and placed on the board. Once the first race program has begun NO ADDITIONAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Starting boxes will be provided for use at the owner/handler's discretion. Please bring an extra person to help you handle your dog(s) if possible.

QUALIFYING RUNS:

All first time entered dogs must do a qualifying run prior to the race meet. You may sign up for qualifying runs on race morning at the registration table.

SINGLES RACING:

Entries will be limited to TEN (10) DOGS TOTAL (limit one dog per household). Entries will be taken on a first come, first served basis. Once the entry limit has been reached, we will start a waiting list.

** Please Note: Singles racing was created to meet the needs of dogs who, for whatever reason, are not able to run in the company of other dogs. IT IS NOT THE SAME AS PRACTICE. Dogs participating in Singles are expected to be fully schooled, meaning that they will reliably chase the lure for the entire length of the track/course, wearing a muzzle and a blanket. If your dog does not fit this description, then please sign up for practice runs instead.

PRACTICE RUNS:

Practices will be offered in between race programs and after the awards ceremony. Practice runs will be conducted according to the sign-up sheet at the registration table. If a dog has already run once, it may not run a second time until other dogs on the list have had at least one turn to run. We will try to accommodate everyone but we are limited to the time/sunlight we have available. You may sign up for practices on race morning at the registration table.

REGISTRATION FOR LGRA:

All LGRA participants must be registered with LGRA in order to enter the meet. Registration applications can be downloaded from the LGRA website. You may register your dog on the day of the meet. To do that, attach a copy of your hound's registration certificate from AKC, UKC, etc to your race meet entry form.

REGISTRATION FOR IWRO:

All whippets must be registered with IWRO. To register, send a copy of your hound's registration papers and \$1.00 application fee to Jack Lewis, Organization Director, 13765 South 1300 West Riverton, Utah 84065.

REGISTRATION FOR AOK9 and SINGLES:

All first-time AOK9 and Singles participants must be registered with RACE in order to enter the meet. Registration applications can be downloaded from the AOK9 website (http://aok9racing.weebly.com/) and submitted along with your entry form. Applications will also be available at the registration table on race morning.

OVERNIGHT CAMPING

Dry Camping is \$30/night and must be booked through Rachelle (phone: 530-656-2704, email: lakeminden_admin@equitylifestyle.com). Showers and toilets are available on site; no electrical hookups, no water hookups. Dogs are NOT allowed in the showers or bathrooms.

RV Camping must be booked through Thousand Trails (https://www.rvonthego.com/california/lake-minden-rv-resort/?utm_source=yext&utm_medium=directory&utm_campaign=Yext%20Directory%20Listing) Full water and electrical hookups are available, but you also have access to the showers and toilets on site. Dogs are NOT allowed in showers or bathrooms.

Cabin Camping must be booked through Thousand Trails (see link above). Sleep 5 studio cabins are \$125/ night, but there's only 2 (and they book fast). Sleep 6 cabins are \$145/night. Dogs must be crated/contained while inside the cabin.

POTLUCK LUNCH

We will have a potluck lunch both days. Drinks and tableware will be provided by the club.

AWARDS

High Score rosettes will be awarded to all breed/division winners. Placement 1-5 ribbons will be awarded to the top five racers in each breed/division.
